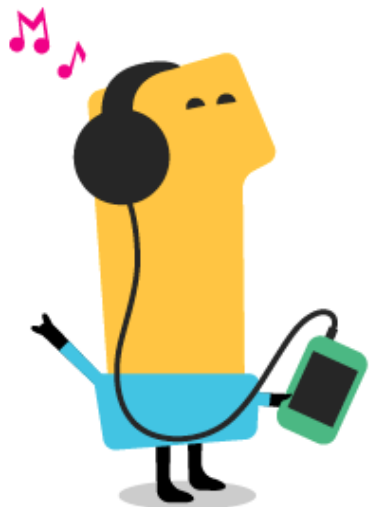

MeeGo Community: What and Who



- Community includes all of the people who work on or with MeeGo
 - **Product contributors:** kernel / distribution developers, release managers, quality assurance, localization, etc.
 - **App developers:** writing applications to run on top of MeeGo
 - **Users:** people who run MeeGo on their device and provide feedback
 - **Vendors:** companies creating products based on MeeGo
 - **Other contributors:** promotion, moderation, documentation and more

Some people contribute as part of their employment at companies like Intel and Nokia, while others contribute free time. The community includes all of these people who are doing interesting work on MeeGo.

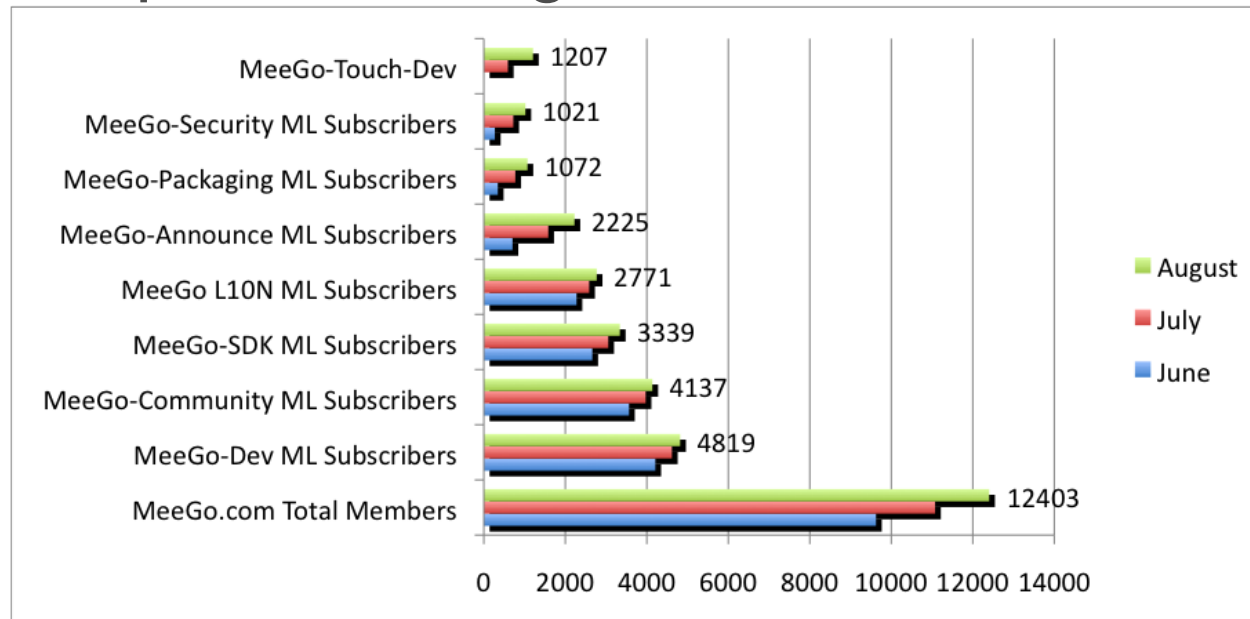

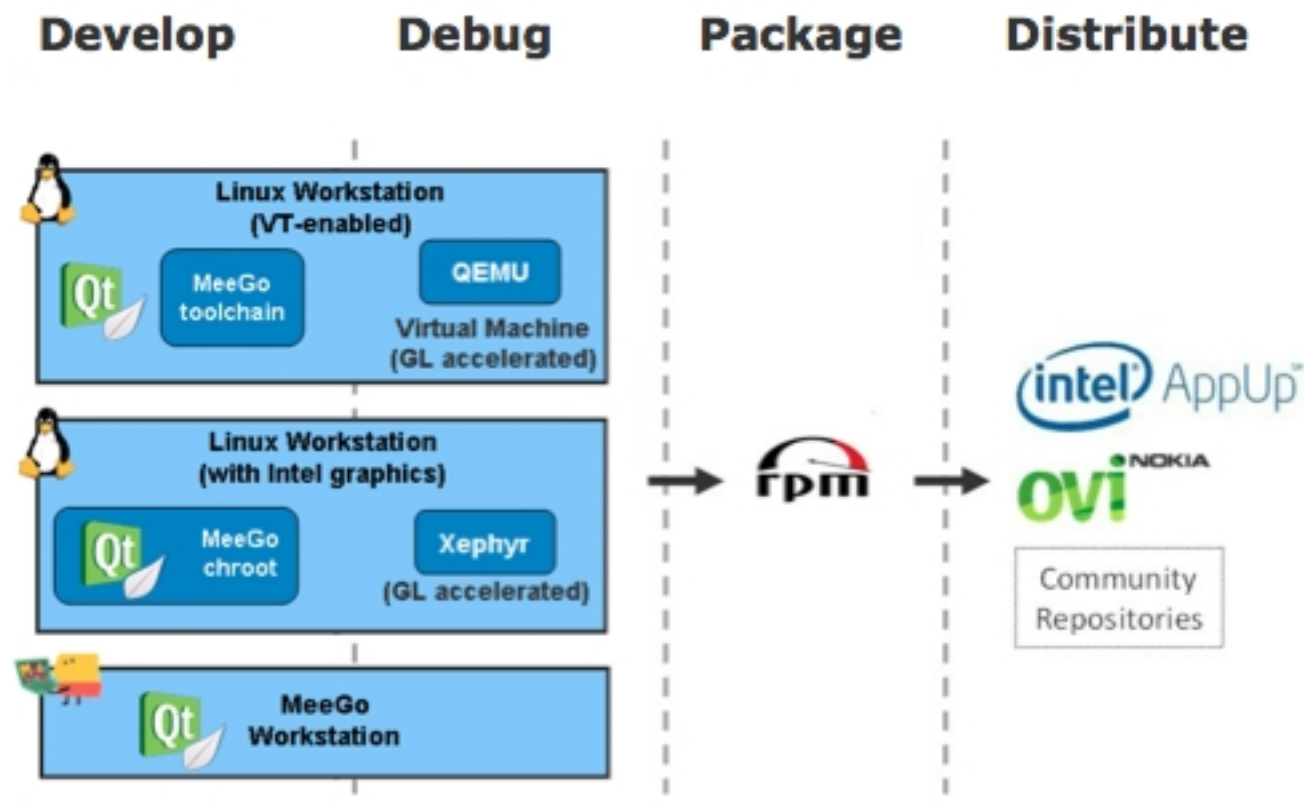

- Web runtimes

- Localization / Translation



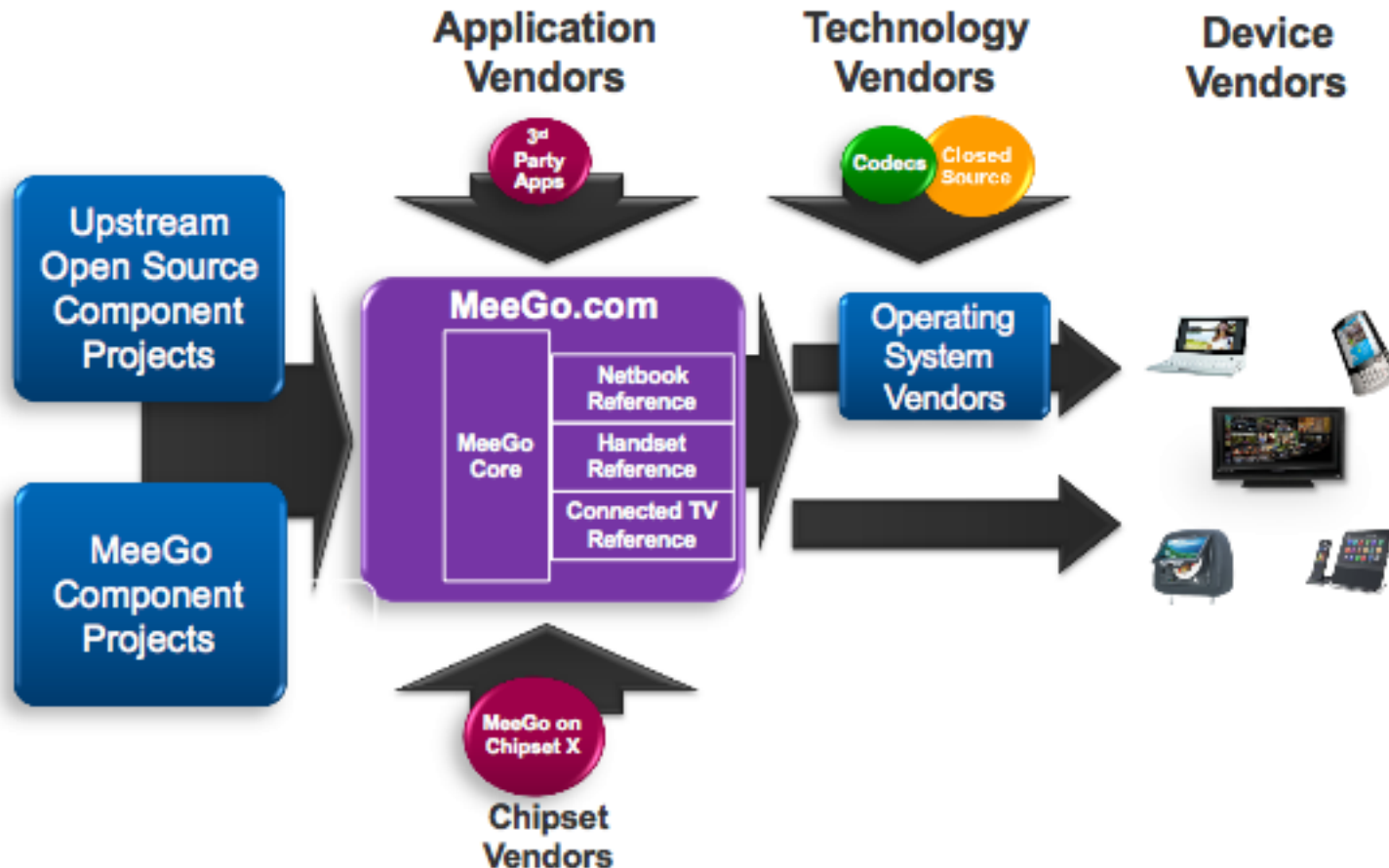
